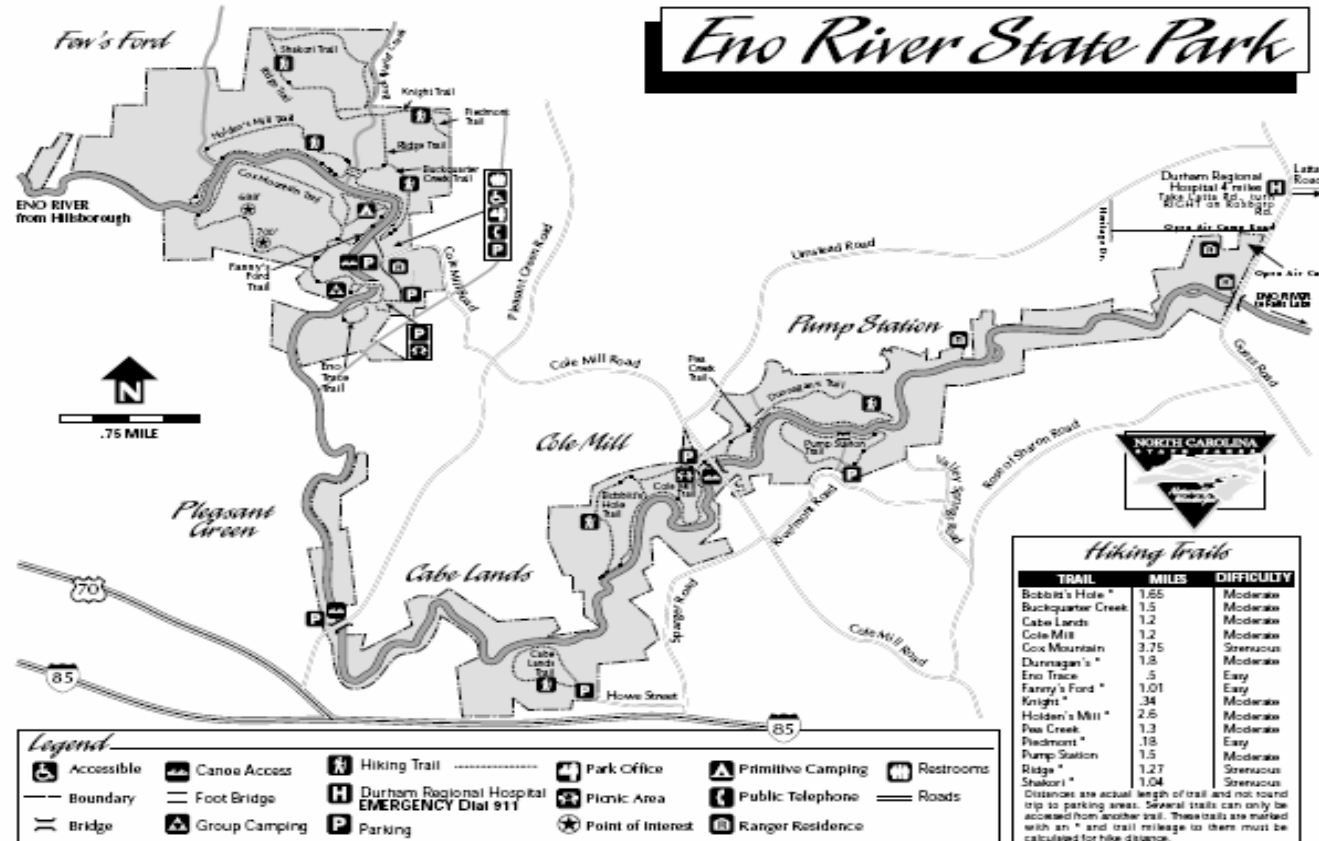

Eno River - Access Points

- Eno River State Park
 - Few's Ford
 - Pleasant Green
 - Cabe Lands
 - Cole Mill
 - Pump Station
- Penny's Bend
 - White bass and crappie with extreme crowds

Eno River - Gear

- Felt sole boots
- 8' 4 wt overall
- Flies:
 - Streamers (10 to 12)
 - Foam beetles (8 to 12)
 - Elk Hair Caddis (12, 14)
 - Dark Woolly Buggers (8, 10)
 - Bream flies
 - Tailend Charlies, Gil Getters, Poppers, etc
 - Damsel Fly patterns (8)



Eno River - Tips

- USGS web site:

 - Best fishing: 20 to 80 cfs
- Cole Mill access is the shortest hike
- Cabe Lands access is the most strenuous hike
- Fish current seams around deeper water
- If you can't figure out what fly to use, try a dark size 10 Woolly Buggler ...
